NEW AMBULATORY CURRICULUM FOR CMEF

Our new X+Y schedule model brought about many welcomed opportunities this year. Ambulatory practice satisfaction was recently measured and compared to last year. The residents overwhelmingly reported high satisfaction with our new curricular piece, 'Academic Half-Day (96% in 2016 vs 46% in 2015).' Led by Drs. Bolyard and Narayanan, the residents participate in a robust interactive small group session for one half-day of each clinic week. The focus is on landmark clinical trial review, healthcare policy & costs, billing & coding, board review pearls, pictures in medicine, and physical exam skill improvement.
